Flow Chart for New Businesses

- 1. Decision to locate in Johnstown
- 2. Contact the Village Zoning Official to obtain information on Village zoning and occupancy permit requirements. There is a fee paid to the Village for this permit.
- 3. If there is <u>ANY</u> structural or electrical to be done a permit is required from the Licking County Building Department. There is a fee paid to the County for this permit. Depending on the work being performed, a permit may also be needed from the Monroe Township Fire Department.
- 4. If there is <u>ANY</u> plumbing work to be done a permit may be required from the Licking County Health Department. There is a fee paid to the County for this permit.
- 5. If there is a "change of use" as defined by the Ohio Building Code (different from Village zoning), a permit is required from the Licking County Building Department. There is a fee paid to the County for this permit.
- 6. An occupancy certificate must be obtained from the Licking County Building Department if one does not already exist. There is a fee paid to the County for this certificate.
- 7. The acquisition of all appropriate permits and certificates is the obligation of the business owner. Approved architectural drawings may be required by the Licking County Building Department.
- 8. All fire suppression equipment must be serviced.
- 9. If there is a change of use, the building may be required to be brought up to current building and fire code standards per State of Ohio law.
