ENGRAVED BRICKS PAVE THE WAY FOR THE U.S. VETERANS

“WALK OF HONOR”

American Legion Post #254 of Johnstown, Ohio, has kicked off a campaign offering individuals, groups, clubs, and businesses the opportunity to purchase bricks engraved with the names of veterans, past & present. The bricks will be used to build the “WALK of HONOR” which will lead to the pavilion and playground to be built as part of the new American Legion Complex in Johnstown, Ohio.

Gordon Cromwell, Commander of American Legion Post #254, said the new post complex will be beneficial not just to veterans, but also to the families and children in the central Ohio area.

The bricks are four inches by eight inches and may be engraved with the name of your veteran(s), (men or women), branch of service, conflict (if applicable) and years served. The space available for the engraving is 3 lines, with 16 spaces per line, including punctuation.

Post 254 is a **501(C)19** (veteran) organization and ALL donations are **100% tax-deductible**.

Suggested donation for bricks is \$75 each.
