

"WALL OF HONOR" Information

Johnstown American Legion Post 254 "Wall of Honor" was dedicated 22 August 2015 and is located at 180 West Maple Street, Johnstown, Ohio. The "Wall of Honor" structure consists of a recycled stone block base with four pillars covered with stone tablets and brick. Between the Pillars are six (6) panels, three (3) forward panels and three (3) rear panels. Each panel has the capacity of one hundred ninety-five (195) engraved bricks.

Engraved bricks are for recognition of non-profit Military Organizations or an individual that has previously served or is presently serving in the United States Military, Military Reserve or Military National Guard. A Military Organization or person meeting the above criteria that wishes to remain anonymous may inscribe a brick with a quotation. A brick engraving is limited to three (3) lines, with sixteen (16) characters per line. Space breaks must be counted as a character. With each brick request form, a minimum donation of seventy-five dollars (\$75) is required. Brick requests not meeting the above criteria will be rejected.

Located on the pillar stone tablets are engraved inscriptions of the "Wall of Honor" monetary donation supporters. A minimum of three thousand dollars (\$3000) donation is required for a stone tablet engraved inscription. Tablet inscription is chosen by the donation supporter. Small monetary donations to the Wall of Honor Fund would also be greatly appreciated.

Monetary donation moneys are held in a Wall of Honor Fund. This fund is used for "Wall of Honor" routine maintenance, security and improvements to surrounding areas.

A brick or tablet inscription request is subject to rejection by our Johnstown American Legion Post 254 Wall of Honor Committee.
