### **Job Description**

The Johnstown Police Department is accepting applications for qualified Auxiliary Police Officers. Interested individuals should submit an application to the Johnstown Police Department.

The position of Police Officer is under the general supervision of the Division Lieutenant and under the direct supervision of a Sergeant. The individual assuming this position will be responsible for:

- Providing a highly visible, professional police presence while conducting patrol activities in a specified geographical area
- Answering calls when a crime is suspected or an emergency exists
- Taking such actions as necessary to prevent crime and/or to apprehend a criminal
- Maintaining safety and to assist citizens in a wide range of emergency and non-emergency situations
- Taking proper enforcement action as necessary and required to maintain the order, safety, and general welfare of the Village of Johnstown, utilizing the United States Constitution, the Ohio Revised Code and Johnstown Codified Ordinances
- Initiating reports, affecting arrests, processing prisoners, conducting investigations in cooperation with detectives, sharing intelligence information
- Coordinating police resources
- Observing and identifying potential problem areas within the community

### **Job Requirements**

- Age : 21
- Education : High School or GED equivalent
- Experience : OPOTA certification required before hire
- Additional Requirement :
  - Minimum of 21 years of age at time of appointment
  - Must be a United States citizen, with a valid Ohio drivers license
  - The location of an officer's residence must be such that if an officer is contacted and called back to duty in an emergency, the officer can report to the station, ready for duty, within sixty minutes of being contacted. New officers must meet this requirement within six months of appointment
  - Visual acuity – both eyes must have corrected vision of 20/30
