AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 15-13, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY
