



RESOLUTION 13-08

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER
TO APPOINT A POLICE OFFICER**

WHEREAS, the Section 5.04(a) of Village of Johnstown Charter states the Village Manager may “appoint, promote, suspend, remove or otherwise discipline any Municipal employee...,” and;

WHEREAS, Village Council authorized a budget increase to the 2013 budget to hire an additional officer on January 22, 2013, and;

WHEREAS, Police Chief Corbin administered an Officer Test on November 8, 2012, with one candidate present, and;

WHEREAS, the Village Manager and Police Chief hereby recommend that the Village Council provide, by this resolution, the requisite consent and approval for the Village Manager to appoint a Police Officer, contingent upon the candidate’s successful completion of the background check and drug screening;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:


Section 1. Without creating a contract for employment, the Village Council herein provides the requisite consent and approval for the Village Manager to appoint Brian Sherrod to the position of Police Officer, at the rate of \$15.50 per hour, contingent upon the candidate’s successful completion of the background check and drug test. The Police Officer shall be employed at-will and will be subject to the terms and conditions of the Employee Handbook.


Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council, concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution, were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings were open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
