

Resolution 2013-26

A Resolution Amending Resolution 2013-22 and Approving and Committing Capital Improvement Funds for US 62 Two Way Left Turn Lane (LIC-62 4.17)

WHEREAS, Johnstown Village Council has indicated a need for crash reduction and traffic congestion mitigation along US 62 within the Village of Johnstown through a motion for funding at their April 16th, 2013 regular council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Licking County Area Transportation Study conducted a study from logpoint 4.17 to 4.65 and found a segment crash rate of 7.13 per million vehicle miles traveled; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation Central Office DSRT meeting held a meeting on May 10th at 10:30AM to discuss the project and asked for a larger monetary contribution for this project and would not approve a second, similar project (LIC-62 3.60-3.90); and

WHEREAS, the Licking County Transportation Study approved \$800,000 in construction dollars for SFY 2019 at their Policy Meeting on May 14th, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Village Council approved an initial funding proposal at their regular Village Council meeting on June 4th, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager and Service Director met with ODOT representatives on August 7th, 2013 to discuss funding and timing of the project in which it was determined Village Council would need to amend their funding dates; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JOHNSTOWN VILLAGE COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Johnstown Village Council hereby approves the following funding allocation for the LIC-62 4.17 Two Way Left Turn Lane:

The Village's contribution shall be paid from the General Capital Improvement Fund, Water Capital Improvement Fund, and/or Wastewater Capital Improvement Fund in equal proportion of the work to be completed;

SECTION 3.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
