



**RESOLUTION 14-17**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPOINT A FULL TIME POLICE DISPATCHER**

**WHEREAS**, the Section 5.04(a) of Village of Johnstown Charter states the Village Manager may “appoint, promote, suspend, remove or otherwise discipline any Municipal employee...,” and

**WHEREAS**, a full time Police Dispatcher resigned on February 26, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, a notice of vacancy was posted internally on March 5, 2014 through March 19, 2014 in which the Police Chief received two letters of interest one of which was from Sandy Patrick; and

**WHEREAS**, as a current part-time dispatcher, Sandy Patrick had previously and successfully completed the background check and drug test.

**WHEREAS**, the Village Manager and Police Chief hereby recommend that the Village Council provide, by this resolution, the requisite consent and approval for the Village Manager to appoint a Police Dispatcher.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**

Section 1. Without creating a contract for employment, the Village Council herein provides the requisite consent and approval for the Village Manager to appoint Sandy Patrick to the position of Police Dispatcher. The Police Dispatcher shall be employed at-will and will be subject to the terms and conditions of the Employee Handbook.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
