**Resolution Failed**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY CONTRACTS TO INITIATE PHASE I OF THE TRANSPORTATION ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Village never implemented a comprehensive roadway maintenance plan which has led to the rapid deterioration of the roadway system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village currently maintains approximately 38 lane miles of roads throughout the Village and in year 2021, SR 37 and US 62 will become the responsibility of the Village adding 7.5 lanes miles to our network; and

**WHEREAS**, initiation of the Transportation Asset Management Plan (TAM) was made in an effort to systematically evaluate our road system in its current condition and propose upgrades in infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, Phase I of the Transportation Asset Management Plan has identified Concord Road, S. Kasson Street, W. Jersey Street and N. Oregon Street as the top roadway priorities; and

**WHEREAS**, the total approximate cost of roadway improvements for Phase I is \$3,435,775; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village cannot pay for these improvements from existing funding sources therefore must seek grant and loan funding sources; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, Licking County, Ohio as follows:**

**Section One:** The Village Council recognizes the need for roadway repairs and therefore authorizes the Village Manager to act on behalf of the Village to initiate the necessary contracts and documents to complete Phase I of the Transportation Asset Management Plan.

**Section Two:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
