This Election Day, November 6, Ohio voters will decide the next President as well as a number of other federal and local leaders. Ohioans will also have the chance to vote on two Statewide Ballot Issues:

- State Issue 1-Constitutional Convention
- State Issue 2-State-Funded Commission to Draw Legislative and Congressional Districts

As Secretary of State and Chairman of the Ohio Ballot Board, I want to ensure information about these important issues is available and accessible to all Ohio voters and am seeking your help in this endeavor.

The **2012 State Issues Report**, which includes the official ballot language, arguments for and against and the full text of the issues, is now posted prominently on the Secretary of State's website at [www.OhioSecretaryofState.gov](http://www.OhioSecretaryofState.gov) (click on the "What's on the Ballot" button at the bottom of the home page). The Secretary of State's website is also a resource for information on absentee voting, voting early in person and Election Day procedures.

I encourage you to direct interested voters to this web page and, if possible, to include a link to the *2012 State Issues Report* on your own website. For your convenience, you can use the Issues Report widget (available at [www.sos.state.oh.us/SOS/elections/electionofficials/electOffPubs/Widgets.aspx](http://www.sos.state.oh.us/SOS/elections/electionofficials/electOffPubs/Widgets.aspx)) on your website. Your web developer can copy and paste the code to create a custom button that will stand out to Ohio voters who may be visiting your website from now through the election.
