



ORDINANCE NO. 03-2015

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1177 SIGNS TO AMEND CERTAIN
CRITERIA FOR WALL SIGNS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown has included a definition of “wall sign” and certain sign criteria for each zoning district in its Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS the Planning and Zoning Commission passed a motion on March 11, 2015 to recommend to Village Council to amend the sign ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined the need to promote sound design principles and standards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; AND A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1.

The adoption of this legislation as an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, specifically, the adoption of the emergency measure that will benefit the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Johnstown.

Section 2.

Additions to the Zoning Ordinance are shown in grey and deletions are ~~struck~~.

Section 3.

1177.02 (1) DEFINITIONS - (bb) “Wall Sign” means a sign mounted flat against and projecting less no more than 44 3 inches from, or painted on the wall of, a building or structure with the exposed face of the sign in a plane parallel to the face of the wall. This does not include window signs.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN
