



ORDINANCE 01-2016

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF JOHNSTOWN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Johnstown, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Codes need to be updated in order to comply with State law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One That the editing, arrangement and numbering of those ordinances from October 9, 2014 to December 1, 2015, as listed below, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the 2015 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification. A copy of such replacement pages are attached to this ordinance and incorporated as a part hereof.

Section Three The complete text of the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Code sections listed above are set forth in full in the 2015 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A. Any summary publication of this ordinance shall include a complete listing of these sections. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of a new matter contained therein.

Section Four In order to preserve the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the editing and inclusion of certain legislation in the Codified Ordinances is necessary, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section Five It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
