ORDINANCE 14-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 25-15, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2016 on December 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown does hereby desire to amend its appropriations so as to apply for a grant of up to \$100,000.00 from the State of Ohio for the Police Department to purchase two new police cruisers, tasers, and body cameras; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown will not be responsible to pay the \$20,000.00 if the grant application is denied; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One. That the appropriation for the Budget Stabilization Fund that was set forth in Ordinance 25-15, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 15, 2015, be hereby amended to read as follows:

NET EFFECT	(increase)	\$ <u>20,000.00</u>

Section Two. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
