ORDINANCE 24-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 25-15, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2016 on December 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Village Council passed Resolution #2016-18 for the purpose of the regulation of the use of public right of ways in the interest of public safety and convenience, and the operation and protection of public works infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the net effect on the finances of the Village of Johnstown will be an increase of \$27,000; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One. That the appropriation for the Budget Stabilization Fund that was set forth in Ordinance 25-15, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 15, 2015, be hereby amended to read as follows:

Appropriations:

2903-000-0000	(increase)	\$	27,000.00
NET EFFECT	(increase)	\$	27,000.00

Section Two: All fees and receipts associated with the recoupment of costs associated with the right of way ordinance shall be returned to the budget stabilization fund.

Section Three. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
