ORDINANCE 34-2016

*This ordinance is passed only if the ballot issue passes*

**AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT AN INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE INCOME TAX RATE FROM THE CURRENT RATE OF ONE PERCENT (1.0%) TO A RATE OF TWO PERCENT (2.0%) TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 2017 FOR THE PURPOSES OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS AND SERVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, POLICE SERVICES, PARKS AND RECREATION, STREET MAINTENANCE, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, AND RELATED COSTS OF THE VILLAGE, AND TO INCLUDE AT LEAST A SIXTY PERCENT (60%) CREDIT UP TO TWO PERCENT (2.0%) FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, Licking County, Ohio as follows:

**Section One**

Effective January 1, 2017, in addition to the tax imposed by Ordinance 20-2015, there is levied an additional tax of one percent (1%) with at least a sixty percent (60%) credit up to two percent (2%) upon those classes of salaries, wages, commissions, rent, compensation and profits set forth in Ordinance 20-2015, for the purposes of general municipal operations and services, including, but not limited to, police services, parks and recreation, street maintenance, capital improvements, and related costs of the Village.

**Section Two**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Ordinance were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN
