## RESOLUTION 2016-18

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH GGC ENGINEERS FOR THE CREATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMPREHENSIVE RIGHT OF WAY ORDINANCE AND FEE STRUCTURE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village does not have a right of way ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, utility companies have little oversight due to lack of regulation; and

**WHEREAS**, The purpose of a right of way ordinance is the regulation of the use of public right of ways in the interest of public safety and convenience, and the operation and protection of public works infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, Excavation and restoration standards are required to preserve the integrity, operational safety, and function of the public right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, costs associated with the development and implementation of a right of way ordinance are recoupable from utility companies utilizing the public right of way; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1.** Village Council hereby authorizes the Village Manager to enter into an agreement with GGC Engineers for the creation and implementation of a comprehensive right of way ordinance in the amount not to exceed \$27,000.00.

**Section 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
