RESOLUTION 2016-21

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT OF COOPERATION WITH THE JOHNSTOWN MONROE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Johnstown-Monroe Local School District Board of Education (“Board”) is engaged in two co-funded Ohio School Facilities Commission Classroom Facilities Assistance Program projects to construct a new high school building and a new elementary school building within the Johnstown Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the school district voted to issue bonds for the construction of new school facilities, with the State of Ohio paying 29% of the project costs thus reducing the burden on the local taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the school district is limited within Ohio School Facilities Construction Commission budget to normal and customary site costs; and

WHEREAS, the school district conducted a traffic impact study for the new high school and elementary school;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Johnstown Village Council that;

Section 1. Village Council emphasizes the construction of the Caswell Road connector as the first priority for traffic mitigation and requests the school district for priority consideration of the connector.

Section 2. Village Council will continue to work towards a joint resolution with all impacted parties for the construction of a traffic signal at Leafy Dell Road and N. Main Street.

Section 3. Village Council acknowledges if the Caswell Road connector is built, there will not be a requirement for a two way left turn lane on S. Main Street as recommended by the February 2015 Traffic Impact Study completed by GPD Group.

Section 4. Village Council will not delay the opening of any school facility if the traffic maintenance infrastructure is not in place at the time of scheduled opening.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
