RESOLUTION 2016-23

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AMERICAN LEGION POST 254 AND THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Johnstown American Legion Post 254 continuously assists in efforts to foster a culture of service, citizenship, and responsibility through volunteerism; and

WHEREAS, Post 254 is taking steps to become a certified Disaster Response Post through the American Legion Disaster Preparedness and Response Program; and

WHEREAS, Post 254 will be required to go through the Licking County Emergency Management Agency and complete the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program; and

WHEREAS, once certified, Post 254's goal is to provide a service of response to the Village of Johnstown by coordinating with local law enforcement and emergency services; developing community action plans, assessing possible threats and identifying local resources; and

WHEREAS, as former members of the Armed Forces trained in vigilance and security, who would be more qualified citizens than veterans to assist in many community security activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Johnstown Village Council that;

Section 1. Village Council supports the Johnstown American Legion Post 254 in their effort to become a nationally recognized Disaster Response Post.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.


