


# VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN



## ORDINANCE 01-2017

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 42-16, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2017 on December 6, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, Schlabach Builders Ltd. is moving forward with residential housing development of the land in Concord Crossing East, and has written a check to the Village of Johnstown for \$17,465.00 to cover the costs to be incurred during the mandatory inspection of streets and utilities in Concord Crossing East; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Johnstown does hereby desire to amend its appropriations so as to address these costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the net effect on the finances of the Village of Johnstown will be \$0; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

**Section One.** That the appropriations for the General Fund that were set forth in Ordinance 42-16, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 6, 2016, be hereby amended to read as follows:
