ORDINANCE 18-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 42-16, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2017 on December 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Johnstown has received reimbursement from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the pedestrian bridge which was constructed in 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown will expend a portion of this reimbursement to pay ODOT for work performed in 2014 to install curbing on South Main Street as part of ODOT's SR 37 paving project.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One. That the revenues and appropriations for the Village Capital Projects Fund that were set forth in Ordinance 42-16, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 6, 2016, be hereby amended to read as follows:
