ORDINANCE 23-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 42-16, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2017 on December 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Johnstown Police Department is in need of new police vests; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown desires to purchase new vests using General Fund dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:
