## ORDINANCE 35-2017

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 42-16,  
THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE  
NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2017 on December 6, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Johnstown Administration and Police Departments are currently serviced by Alphalink for phone and Internet; and,

**WHEREAS**, the level of service granted by the current provider has been very poor since the beginning of the service period and has not improved, and the safety and security of the residents of the Village of Johnstown are placed at a higher level of risk when the service fails; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Johnstown desires to separate from the current provider and use a different provider that utilizes a cable network; and

**WHEREAS**, the switch to a different service provider requires some initial capital costs for new system software, hardware, and installation and has received a quote from ECR Computers for \$12,530.00 to cover these costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Budget Stabilization fund balance is sufficient to cover this appropriation.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

**Section One.** That the appropriations for the Budget Stabilization Fund that were set forth in Ordinance 42-16, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 6, 2016, be hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section Two.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.

**Section Three.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare at the earliest possible time; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


