ORDINANCE 36-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 42-16, THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN TO APPROVE NECESSARY CHANGES OF APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Johnstown adopted its annual appropriations for 2017 on December 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown Police Department is in need of new recording devices for local police traffic and digital file storage of said recordings; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnstown Police Department has received a quote from Vasu Communications/ECR Computers for \$3,081.98 to purchase and install these devices; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Stabilization fund balance is sufficient to cover this appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, Licking County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One. That the appropriations for the Budget Stabilization Fund that were set forth in Ordinance 42-16, adopted by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, State of Ohio, on December 6, 2016, be hereby amended to read as follows:

Section Two. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.


Section Three. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare at the earliest possible time; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
