**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY TO GOVERN THE STORAGE OF NON-VILLAGE EQUIPMENT ON VILLAGE PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village from time to time is asked to assist the community in storage of property that is not owned ; and

**WHEREAS**, in certain situations Village Council may determine it is in the best interest of the community to allow for the storage of non-Village equipment on Village property; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Village Council of the Village of Johnstown approves the following attached policy for the storage of non-Village equipment.



# Village of Johnstown Storage of Non-Village Equipment/Property

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## GOALS:

The goals of the Village's policy are:

1. To reduce liability to the Village when storing non-Village owned equipment and property.
2. To clarify the process to store non-Village equipment under special circumstances.

## POLICIES:


The following are the policies set forth for the storage of non-Village owned equipment and/or property:

1. The Village of Johnstown shall not store or allow storage of non-Village owned equipment and/or property.
2. If and when a situation arises where it would make sense to do so, the Village Council can at that time allow it under those circumstances, and must enter into a letter of understanding that the Village will assume no responsibility for the items or any damage, harm, etc. caused by or to the items.
3. Any allowance of storage will be documented by Resolution of Council with the letter of understanding attached.
