### A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE COUNCIL RULES AND PROCEDURES

**Whereas**, Section 3.07 of the Charter of the Village of Johnstown states that Council shall adopt its own rules which will remain in effect until amended or repealed by Council; and

**Whereas**, the Rules of Order shall provide for such matters as Council shall determine to be necessary for the proper functioning and governance of Council; and

**Whereas**, at the February 28, 2017 meeting, the Rules Committee voted 2-0 to amend the Council Rules of Order as follows ; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Johnstown, Licking County, Ohio as follows:

**Section One:** Additions to Council Rules of Order are shown in grey and deletions are ~~struck~~.

#### **SECTION IX. ROLL CALL AND VOTING PROCEDURES**

9.02 Every member present when a question is put shall vote unless the member has direct personal interest. Any member who abstains from voting may must make a brief statement of the reason for making such a vote. The questions shall then be immediately taken without further debate. A majority of those voting shall prevail.

**Section Two:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that meetings of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter of the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
