A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PARTICIPATE IN OUTSIDE TEACHING ACTIVITIES

Whereas, the Village Manager and Village Council entered into contract on August 20, 2014; and

Whereas, Section 15 of said contract allows the Village Manager to accept certain outside teaching opportunities; and


Whereas, the Village Manager has an opportunity to teach another public administration class at Muskingum University beginning January 8, 2018 through May 9, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Village Council hereby authorizes the Village Manager to continue participating in teaching activities with Muskingum University; with the understanding that no Village facilities, equipment (excluding cellular phone and laptop), or paid time will be utilized in the performance of these or related non-village responsibilities and as is consistent with the current employment contract for the duration of the summer 2018 semester.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an open meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
