



**RESOLUTION 2018-08**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO RESEARCH AND DISCUSS WITH SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES AND BUSINESSES FOR THE EXTENTION OF WATER & SEWER FACILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Johnstown has excess capacity at their water and wastewater facilities, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Columbus, Southwest Licking Community Water & Sewer District and Del-Co Water have water and/or wastewater infrastructure in close proximity to Johnstown; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect the Village's future growth and expansion, it may be necessary to extend water and wastewater infrastructure; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE ITRESOLVED** by Council for the Village of Johnstown, Counties of Licking, State of Ohio, that:

**Section 1.** The Village Manager and staff are hereby instructed to discuss future utility line extensions to the north, west and south of the Village boundary with other communities and businesses.

**Section 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the recommendation of adoption of this Resolution were approved in an opening meeting of this Village Council and that meetings resulted in such formal action where meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Charter for the VILLAGE OF JOHNSTOWN.
